

- Q What is the rationale behind saphenous vein-saving surgery (CHIVA)?
- ♀ What is the ultrasound technique of patient selection for CHIVA?
- What is saw-knife phlebectomy?
- What are the benefits of cryovaricectomy?
- Q Can we do crossectomy with lasers?
- Q Can we do laser surgery of thrombotic or inflamed segments of saphenous stems?
- Is it better or worse to save the tributaries at the sapheno-femoral junction during heat ablation?
- A How can I do laser surgery of recurrent varicosity after classic surgery?
- What does a 10 year experience with varicose vein laser surgery reveal?
- Q Can we tell in advance who will suffer a post-ablation recurrent varicosity?
- What is the influence of pregnancy on laser surgery results?
- What is the difference between foam and froth sclerotherapy?
- A How many ways are there to get rid of post-sclerotherapy clots?
- Is it beneficial to do foam sclerotherapy and laser ablation from the same puncture?
- Are there AV shunts behind corona phlebectatica paraplantaris?
- What are the benefits and drawbacks of new anticoagulants in clinical practice?
- A How can venous malformations be sclerosed?
- Is it a muscle hernia or a varicose vein in the leg?
- What are the sources and typical conditions for spontaneous varicose vein bleeding?
- Are there lymphoedemas after varicose vein surgery?
- What is new in crural ulcer diagnostics and treatment?
- Q Lymphoedema and lipoedema: how to treat them?
